*Friday, October 30* (Time TBA), there will be a panel discussion titled-- Academic Integrity Strategies for Secondary Schools, where panelists (adults and students) from public and private schools have been recruited to discuss from a practitioner's view point the successful academic integrity strategies at their schools.

This discussion will explore the conditions under which students are most likely to cheat and to view their cheating as morally justified. It will also explore approaches to reduce cheating along with efforts to build a moral academic community.
